

## PROFESSIONAL TIMBER HARVESTER TRAININGPROGRAM



Earth disturbances\* resulting from:

- Haul Roads
- Skid Roads/Trails
- Log Landings

NOTICE: This chart is intended to provide a general idea of what paperwork and permits might be required for timber harvesting related activities under Chapter 102 of the PA Code. It is for informational purposes only. Timber harvest administrators should always consult the regulations and/or seek out assistance from DEP or their local County Conservation District regarding the specific circumstances of their operations.

5,000 square feet or more of total earth disturbance

and/or

Operation will likely discharge into <u>High</u> <u>Quality (HQ) or Exceptional Value (EV)</u> <u>streams or watersheds</u>

and/or

DEP permit(s) required

Must develop, implement, and

maintain a written E&S plan†

Less than 5,000 square feet of total earth disturbance, not in an HQ or EV watershed, and no DEP permits required

Written E&S plan not required, but implementation and maintainance of BMPs still required

25 acres or more of earth disturbance

Erosion and Sedimentation Control Permit Required

- \* Land clearing operations must be covered under the developer's NPDES permit.
- † Must be prepared by a person trained and experienced in E&S control methods and techniques applicable to the size and scope of the operation.
